

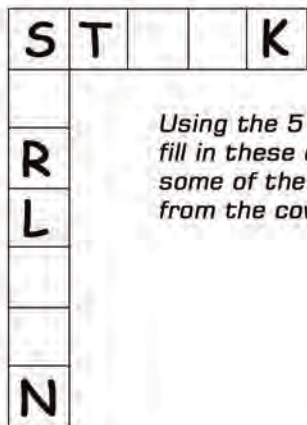
Cows have the 'stomachs' for corn!

WHO KNEW?

Cows have 32 teeth! But they don't have any teeth on the top at the front! Because these teeth are missing, food such as corn silage and hay doesn't get broken down in their mouths easily. To help digest their food cows have 4 stomachs! When they swallow their food - almost unchewed - it is broken down in the first stomach, the rumen, by bacteria. It's then pushed back up into the cows mouth where they chew it over and over again for 6 to 8 hours!

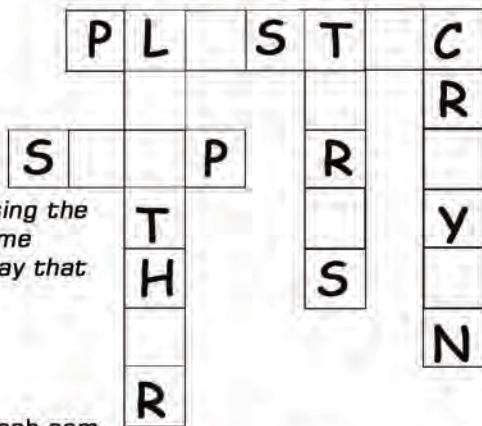
This is called chewing the cud.
